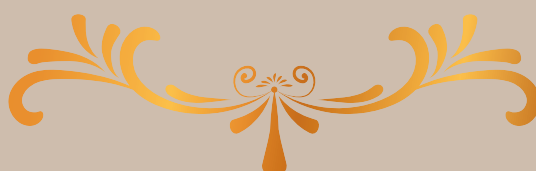
Major renovation works of the school building have also been successfully completed, while further enhancements will continue in phases to create safer, more engaging, and future-ready learning spaces.

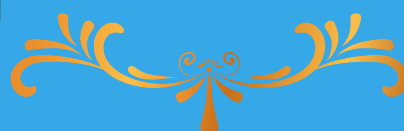




URDU DEPARTMENT HIGHLIGHTS

Reflecting on the Significance of Arafah Day

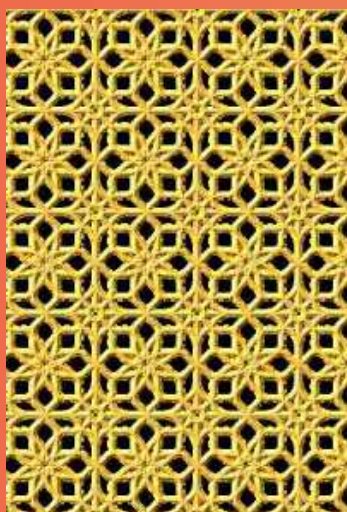

The initiative reflects the school's dedication to supporting the wellbeing of its staff and fostering a positive workplace culture where health, productivity, and professional excellence go hand in hand.

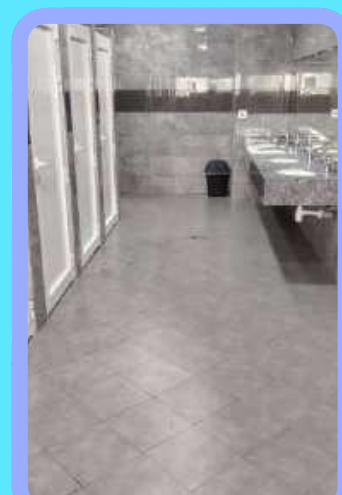




TRANSFORMING SPACES, ENHANCING LEARNING
